From May 11 until May 2017, 380 golfers competed in the monthly fixtures of LSWGS. This is higher than last year. The weakest months turnout were July (18) and April (20).

This is an average of 27,14 players per month. (4% increase on last year)

During the past 14 events we have recorded 3 wins for Terry Wright , two wins for JP Cuvelier and one win for Randy Bishman, Noel Prentice, Neil Raymond, Mark Cameron, Craig Chapman, Stephen Ahmoye, Simon Ruckert, Nick Gikas (our new Masters) and Peter Aherne. 11 different winners...but no winner for Dallas Reid, winner of 3 events in 2015/16..

Match Play Competition : it is important to mention that this competition is organized to enhance the contacts between members outside the monthly competitions and you should try to book your matches outside the monthly competitions to match the deadline. Winner last year : Randy Bishman from Rob Henderson.

The Order of Merit 2016 was won by Terry Wright in front of Rob Henderson. The edition 2017 is led so far by YB Rai.
